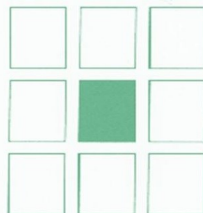

## How to get audiobooks and eBooks using an Android Device

The OverDrive app is a great way to quickly borrow and enjoy eBooks and audiobooks from your library.

If you'd rather enjoy titles without installing an app, you can use your web browser to read OverDrive Read eBooks. To read eBooks directly in your browser, skip to step 4 in the instructions below.

You can find your library's digital collection using the **Add a library** feature in the app or by running a search on [overdrive.com](http://overdrive.com). When you sign up for an OverDrive account, you can save your libraries and enjoy other great features.

**Note:** If you're using a legacy version of our app, you can find a library using the "Get Books" feature, and you won't be prompted to create or log into an OverDrive account.

## How to borrow titles on your Android Device

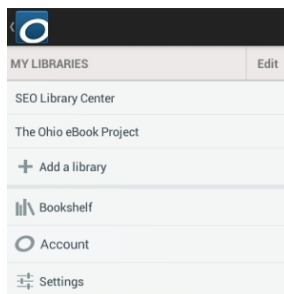
1. Install OverDrive's app from Google Play, the Amazon Appstore, or [app.overdrive.com](http://app.overdrive.com), and sign up for (or sign into) your OverDrive account.
2. From the app, tap the icon in the top-left corner to open the **Home menu** to find your saved libraries list. Or, if you're using the

legacy version of our app, tap the icon near the top-right corner of the screen (if you don't have this button, go to *Menu > Get Books*).

**Note:** The **Menu** button typically looks like

this  or this .

3. Tap a library from the list to go to its digital collection website. If your list is empty, or you need to add a new library, tap **Add a Library** and follow the prompts.



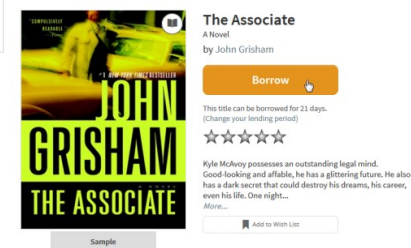
4. On your library website, look for a title that's available to borrow. You can:

- Browse the titles on the home page.
- Use the menu at the top of the page to browse categories.
- Run a search.

5. When you find a title that looks interesting, tap or mouse over it, then tap **Borrow** to check it out.



Or, tap **more** to view the title's details page. From here, tap **Borrow** to check it out. If prompted, sign in.



6. Your library bookshelf will open, displaying the title(s) you've borrowed. From here, you can: Tap **Read (In your browser)** to open the eBook with OverDrive Read.



Or, select a format from the **Download** dropdown menu, then tap **Confirm & Download**. Select **EPUB eBook** or **MP3 audiobook** to download and add the title to your app bookshelf.
